McLane Children's Medical Center is the only pediatric hospital within the Baylor Scott and White Health system in Texas. We service an area that stretches from Dallas to Austin and is wide as San Angelo to College Station, sometimes even beyond.

As the only Children's hospital for the Baylor Scott and White System, we feel a great responsibility to help our system and our surrounding rural areas provide the best pediatric care possible.

In August of 2020, McLane Children's Trauma Team set out to improve education throughout our service region. We started a free trauma curriculum that includes 1 hour CNE and CME education experiences with content experts including nursing, physicians, social workers, forensics, and child life. The curriculum tackles different topics each month that offer pediatric specific scenarios and anatomical, treatment, and presentation differences across the pediatric spectrum.

Because of these efforts, we have seen an increase in pretreatment of trauma patients that, not only align with our treatment goals, but improve patient outcomes. We have built excellent working relationship with hospitals in our service region and been able to provide specific educational request to improve their metrics. But, most importantly, our patients report consistently excellent care from prehospital treatment to discharge.

Through the support of our leadership at McLane Children's, we are able to continue to offer this program free at this time. At this time, we are able to offer this monthly and plan to continue this outreach as long as time and support allow.
